Creativity in the Classroom is five fun and engaging workshops for classroom teachers, teaching artists and other interested community members. The series is designed for those new to teaching the visual and performing arts as well as those with a full range of experience. Workshops include drawing, painting, ceramics, dance, music, drama, poetry and playmaking.

Participants explore their own creativity and gain skills and knowledge to integrate a variety of disciplines into language arts, social studies, science and math. They are introduced to the Visual and Performing Arts Content Standards and explore discussion strategies that apply to the arts and to all student work. Strong emphasis is placed on practices that support the creation of a safe, supportive environment for creative exploration and expression. Community Building and English Language Development strategies are part of each session.
